What is Luzie?

Luzie is an institution of the Karlsruhe youth welfare service which helps girls and young women between the ages 14 to 21 who find themselves in difficult living conditions. Examples of such situations are:

- difficulties at school, at work or during a job training
- stressful issues with their parents
- dangers that manifest themselves in the form of self-inflicted injuries, denial or aggression

Legal

Luzie is meant as Child-Raising Assistance ("Hilfe zur Erziehung") in compliance with German laws (§§ 27, 29, 30, 41 SGBVIII) or court order according to § 10 JGG.

Experiencing a „Sense of Belonging“

Since 2006 the Socio-Therapeutic Union for Child Welfare („Sozialtherapeutischer Jugendhilfeverbund“) subsumes and connects every AWO institution that offers Child-Raising Assistance („Hilfe zur Erziehung“) according to SGBIII.

Within the Union, different services may be combined to collectively find a tailor-made solution for the adolescent. AWO provides its infrastructure for this cooperative effort.

The offered services are further developed and supplemented by the Social Service, the Juvenile Legal Support Agency („Jugendgerichtshilfe“) as well as other cooperating partners.



Creating a Network

We offer

- a support concept which takes into account both – the abilities and difficulties of the adolescents.

Our work

- incorporates the social environment („Lebenswelt“) of the young girls and women and relates their personal history to their recent problems.
- is partial and strongly influenced by the supportive viewpoint of a social education worker which enables the girls to examine possibilities and limitations.
- is confidential and includes the continuous participation of the adolescents when it comes to defining content and goals of our assistance.

Enrollment

- takes place in close cooperation with everyone involved and with the Social Service or the Juvenile Legal Support Agency („Jugendgerichtshilfe“). Before being accepted, applicants are invited to meet and get to know the staff and become familiar with the building and the program’s content and objectives.



Developing Perspectives

A comprehensive concept of assistance

The program has three aspects: one-on-one work between the participant and a counselor, continuous group work and free time activities. This results in:

- the development and shaping of a realistic school / work perspective.
- the support of individual skills and the use of personal resources.
- boosting of self-confidence and a positive body feeling.
- the ability of girls and young women to realize her needs and to reflect on her own behavior.
- the teaching of competences concerning the development of relations between people.
